

FREE TREE OFFER FOR BUCKHORN PROPERTY OWNERS

At the March 30, 2019, Buckhorn POA Annual Membership Meeting, John Eastman (who owns property in the Buckhorn development) made a presentation about a new philanthropic program that he is involved in which provides certain types of trees (dogwood and certain fruit/oaks), as well as the necessary planting supplies for the trees, at no expense to landowners.

As a kick-off to the program, John brought approximately 500 seedling trees (dogwood, common apple, sawtooth and other oaks) to the annual meeting, which were distributed to POA members. Included with the trees were tubes, stakes, peat, fertilizer, and a weed barrier.

John is prepared to have trees (and necessary planting supplies) available at the 2020 Annual Membership Meeting (Saturday, March 28, 2020) if POA members are interested in getting additional trees. Accordingly, we are trying to get an estimate of the number of individuals who would like to participate in the program to determine the feasibility of repeating the offer. If you are interested, please let me know by March 8, 2020, via email or text the number and kind(s) of trees you would like (oak, including sawtooth, dogwood, apple). I also will need your name, address, Buckhorn Lot Number(s) and whether the trees will be planted at your home address or on your Buckhorn property.
